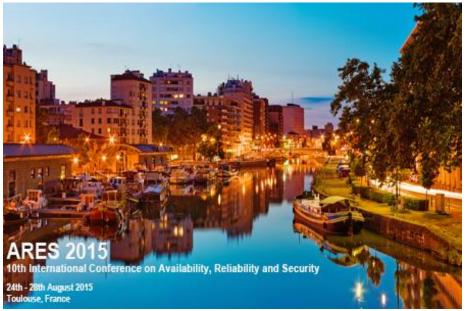


CALL FOR EU PROJECT WORKSHOPS FOR "THE ARES EU PROJECTS SYMPOSIUM" 2015



GENERAL INFORMATION

The 10th International Conference on Availability, Reliability and Security (ARES) will be held from 24 - 28 August 2015 at the Université Paul Sabatier in Toulouse, France.

- ARES will bring together researchers and practitioners in the area of dependability.
- ARES will highlight the various aspects of security with special focus on the crucial linkage between availability, reliability and security.
- ARES aims at a full and detailed discussion of the research issues of security as an integrative concept
 that covers amongst others availability, safety, confidentiality, integrity, maintainability and security
